Dear Parents and Carers,

This morning, I have spoken at length with my colleague, Gary O'Brien, the Principal of Cannon Hill Anglican College. As we are both concerned about the likelihood of more cases of COVID-19 being uncovered in our local area over the coming days, we have made the decision to cancel this weekend's round of TAS Sport.

Whilst we cannot predict the actual level of risk in spread through our local community, this decision to cancel sport is really our only option at this stage.

Canterbury is also re-evaluating our risk assessments of upcoming activities such as camps, excursions, guest speakers and visitors on site.

I continue to encourage any member of our community (students, staff and parents) who has any cold and flu symptoms, or has come into contact with locations mentioned in the recent Queensland Health media release (<https://www.health.qld.gov.au/news-events/doh-media-releases/releases/public-health-alert-three-new-covid-19-cases>), to be tested for COVID-19 and stay away from school whilst they await results.

If for any reason we need to close the school in the event of a verified diagnosis of COVID-19, we will obviously notify parents and students immediately and follow all Queensland Health precautions.
