Vacation Care is a service we offer to families during the school holiday period which operates from 6:45am to 6:00pm daily. The holidays are fast approaching, and we are now accepting bookings for Vacation Care. For bookings, please complete the form below and return it to the Junior School Office or Outside School Hours Care as soon as possible.

Please note bookings close Friday 18 September 2020.

The cost per child is a flat fee of \$47.00 per day and CCS will be applied to this amount. The daily charge will apply for cancellations unless 24 hours' notice is given, or a Doctor's Certificate is provided.

Children are encouraged to participate in the scheduled daily activities but do have the option to opt out. Children may bring an iPad and/or hand-held games only ie: Nintendo DS. Please do not bring school laptops or mobile phones to Vacation Care. OSHC desktops are available and sessions will be held daily for 1 hour in the morning and 1 hour in the afternoon for technology use.

Please ensure you have signed a Permission Form for your child to watch PG rated movies at Vacation Care.

Please send your child with a healthy morning tea and lunch daily. Please ensure your child wears appropriate clothing and shoes to Vacation Care; singlets and thongs are not permitted, and hats must be worn for outside activities. Hair must also be tied back and please supply sunscreen for your child daily. Safety helmets must be worn on Wheels Day; if there is no helmet, then we cannot allow children to participate in riding. Alternative activities will be offered in this situation.
