We offer our families a supportive and stimulating early learning education with highly qualified teachers in vibrant, well-resourced classrooms and engaging outdoor spaces.

Operating from 6:45am-6:00pm,
50 weeks per year. Our rooms all include
long day care as part of the all-inclusive
daily rates.

As a licenced Long Day Care provider, families are eligible to apply for Child Care Subsidy (CCS) through Centrelink. Parents will be invoiced fortnightly in advance with their CCS rebate applied to fee statements.
