RELATIONSHIPS AND AUTHORITY:

This position is responsible to the Deputy Principal and reports to the Director of Sport and Activities for daily operations. The Swim Coach works closely with the Taipans aquatic team. This position is expected to work under limited supervision with broad guidance provided.

POSITION PURPOSE:

The Swimming Coach is a member of the Canterbury Taipans coaching team providing swimming coaching.

The role will be responsible for providing pool attendance, and coaching whilst ensuring the Centre is maintained into a high standard. The role is also responsible for ensuring a safe, useable, and attractive environment, including supporting the Taipans Operations Manager with running of events and activities.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Duties assigned may include any or all the following, according to the Coach's training, qualifications and experience:

Coaching, including:

- Provide students with a positive sporting role model and ensure appropriate conduct at training sessions and meets.
- As outlined by the Director of Sport and Activities, implement a progressive skills, training
 and testing program for all ages and levels of competent swimmers. All programs must be
 visible to the community.
- As outlined by the Director of Sport and Activities, ensure training sessions start on time and are constantly supervised. An accurate attendance record must be kept and produced as requested or required.
- Maintain personal professional qualifications in coaching and water-safety.
- Undertake rostered Pool attendant and Lifeguard duties as required.
- Assist in the coordination of activities, events and functions.

PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

All staff are required to contribute to the collective welfare of the College community. As such they are required to:

- Work collaboratively with their peers to meet position and departmental responsibilities;
- Attend such meetings of department or College staff as requested by their supervisors;
