How it works...

Every semester, each family pays the three compulsory elements that cover their child/ren's all-round education at Canterbury College.

Tuition Fee + Single Resource Charge + Master Plan Building Fund Levy.

Part One: Tuition Fee

Tuition Fees are billed each semester with three payment options available:

Families opting for the new 5 x instalments method, need to complete this **ONLINE APPLICATION FORM**, then submit it to our **Family Liaison Finance Officer**. Payment plans will be managed by the College. NB: Direct debits from bank savings accounts incur no processing fees. Credit card transactions incur a processing fee of 1.32% – 1.7% from Mastercard or Visa.

Sibling Discounts

Families with two or more children enrolled at Canterbury receive sibling discounts on their Tuition Fees. All children must be listed together on the one fee account and must reside at the same household. Sibling discounts apply to Tuition Fees only.

Part Two: Single Resource Charge (SRC)

This consolidated amount covers all core educational materials: textbooks, software licenses, learning apps, MyCC, cocurricular resources, outdoor education camps (Years 3-11), ID card, printing

and copying, yearbooks, JTAS Sport registration, and Surface Pro laptop computer with keyboard, stylus, protective case, carry bag, warranty and Accidental Damage Protection Plan (Years 4-11).

The SRC is specific to each year level and is billed every semester as follows:

The Single Resource Charge does NOT include:

- Vocational Education & Training (VET) courses at the Certificate or Diploma level.
- Subject-specific camps or non-curriculum excursions.
- Major events such as the Year 12 Formal, Valedictory Dinner and Year 10 Social.
- Musical instrument hire plus Music, Dance or Speech and Drama studio lessons.
- Canterbury Taipans Sporting Club memberships and activities.

Part Three: Master Plan Building Fund Levy

This levy allows Canterbury to maintain or improve its educational, sport, performing arts and outdoor facilities, and prioritise its Master Plan projects, to optimise every child's campus experience.

In 2024, these funds will be directed towards outdoor play spaces around the new Junior School C Block building, and to cover outdoor study spaces in the Secondary School.

A levy of \$190 is billed each semester to every family's account.

General Conditions

1. All Canterbury College enrolments are accepted on the basis that full and honest disclosure of all individual learning needs have been made during the application process.

Failure to adhere to this requirement may result in the student's enrolment being cancelled.
2. Tuition fees are effective from **1 January** each year and will remain until such time as they are changed by the College Board.

The Board reserves the right to change fees at any time.
3. Parents/carers who have signed the Enrolment Contract with the College, are jointly and separately liable for the student's fees, and any other associated costs, unless a court order specifies differently.

Copies of any relevant court orders or any documents stating alternate arrangements must be provided to the College.
4. Semester fees can be paid in one full payment or two equal direct debit instalments.

A third option to pay semester fees in five equal direct debit instalments can be requested by completing this **ONLINE APPLICATION FORM**, then submitting it to our **Family Liaison Finance Officer**.

Your application will be reviewed by our Finance Department and access will be given for you to review your payment plan on MyCC's Parent Lounge/Accounts and Payments.

5. The Principal may grant a time extension for payment in exceptional circumstances outside the parents' control.

A request for a payment time extension must be made in writing to the Principal, prior to the due date, and emailed via fees@canterbury.qld.edu.au
6. A student cannot commence a new term at the College if the fees for the previous term remain unpaid, or arrangements with the College have not been made.
7. A student cannot participate in any activities where supplementary charges are levied, if tuition fees are in arrears, unless prior arrangements have been made with the College.
8. Parents/carers must give a minimum of one full term's notice in writing to the College, prior to withdrawing any of their children from Canterbury.

If the withdrawal is to occur at the end of the school year, written notice must be given by the end of the first week of Term 4.

If parents/carers fail to provide notice in accordance with this policy, they will be charged the subsequent term's fees.
9. A monthly administration fee, as per the Fee Policy, will be charged on overdue accounts, plus interest.
10. After 21 days, the College reserves the right to refer all outstanding accounts to a third-party collection agency for the recovery of fees, interest and costs.
