

Dear Parents and Carers,

Canterbury has a rich and thriving co-curricular dance program on offer to all students. This letter outlines the dance opportunities for students in Canterbury's Junior School in 2025. Information about each ensemble and auditions is detailed on the following pages, including costs and requirements.

Dance Ensemble Information

ELC (Early Learning Centre) and Prep: Little Groovers Dance Class is a non-auditioned dance class providing an opportunity for students in ELC and Prep to participate in dancing for enjoyment with the College. The goal of this team is to build a love of music, dance and movement in a safe and fun environment. Little Groover Prep will perform at Dance Spectacular in September.

Years 1-2: Rise Dance Class is a non-auditioned dance class providing an opportunity for students in Years 1-2 to participate in dancing for enjoyment with the College. The goal of this group is to develop musicality, coordination, confidence and stage presence whilst learning skills in the jazz dance style. Students will perform at Dance Spectacular in September.

Years 3-6: BoyZone is a non-auditioned dance class taught with a focus on boys' dance choreography and general enjoyment of dancing. Students will perform at Dance Spectacular in September.

Years 2-3: Shine Dance Company is an auditioned dance team providing an opportunity for students in Years 2-3 to participate in competitive dancing with the College. The goal of this team is to build on existing skills in musicality, coordination, confidence and stage presence whilst developing skills in the jazz and lyrical dance style. Students will compete in eisteddfods and perform at school events throughout the year.

Years 3-6: Flame Dance Class is a non-auditioned dance class providing an opportunity for students in Years 3-6 to participate in dancing for enjoyment with the College. The goal of this group is to develop musicality, coordination, confidence and stage presence whilst learning skills in the jazz dance style. Students will perform at Dance Spectacular in September.

Years 4-6: Ignite Dance Company is an auditioned dance team providing an opportunity for students in Years 4-6 to participate in competitive dancing with the College. The goal of this team is to build on existing skills in musicality, coordination, confidence and stage presence whilst developing skills in the jazz and lyrical dance style. Students will compete in eisteddfods and perform at school events throughout the year.

Years 4-6: Blaze Crew is an auditioned dance team providing an opportunity for students in Years 4-6 to participate in competitive dancing with the College. The goal of this team is to build on skills in the hip hop style. Students will compete in eisteddfods and perform at school events throughout the year. Students in the Blaze Crew are permitted to also participate in either Flame Dance Class or Ignite Dance Company if they wish.

Southern Federation of Dance Technique (Year 4 and above)

This is a jazz technique class where students study the Southern Federation of Dance exam syllabus and prepare for an optional exam at the end of the year. These skills further enhance dance technical and expressive abilities to support excellence across all ensembles.

Expectations and Requirements of Dancers and Families

Participation in Canterbury Dance requires a full-year commitment; dancers are expected to maintain a 90% attendance rate at classes and rehearsals as well as attend all performances and competitions. Students must wear their full correct uniform (including listed footwear), as outlined in the uniform guide, to all classes and performances. Hair must always be neatly tied back as per the College hair policy. For the safety of all dancers and staff, high behaviour expectations, as per the College behaviour policy, exist for all lessons.

What to bring/wear:

- Students are to be collected from the CEC at the conclusion of their audition.

Out of respect for all dancers, family members are **not permitted** in the room during the auditions.

Important Notice

Auditions are always competitive, with many students attending each year. As there are limited places available, we unfortunately cannot accommodate everyone, and decisions made by staff are final. Please also note that acceptance into a team for one year does not guarantee acceptance in subsequent years.

All auditioning students' parents will receive an email by Friday 1 November to inform them of whether their child has been offered a place in an auditioned team. If unsuccessful at gaining a place, students will still be able to enrol in a non-audition ensemble before the end of the year for 2025. Students do not need to audition if they would only like to be in Little Groovers, Rise, Flame or Boyzone Dance Class.
