

Dear Parents and Carers,

I very much hope that your child is excited and eagerly anticipating their Canterbury Senior School journey starting next year! Below is some further information about the start of next year and some key dates to be aware of.

Term 1, 2026 will commence on Wednesday 28 January. To ensure that all of our students are fully prepared for their first class, we have arranged two events:

Thursday 22 January – Device Collection:

All new students to Canterbury in 2026 will be able to collect their laptop computers at 11:00am. Students and parents should come to F block, from where the devices will be distributed prior to a short introductory 'getting started' session, which will conclude by 12:00pm. Please see the attached information from the IT department regarding this and also the Student Device Agreement and Technology Use Guidelines.

Tuesday 27 January – Orientation Day and Sports Trials:

This day is for all our new Senior School students, and will ensure that they have their timetables, textbooks and lockers ready to go for Day 1 the following day, as well as further opportunities to get to know their Head of House, Assistant Head of House and their House student leaders. There will also be an "IT bootcamp," which will follow on from the previous session on 22 January, and ensure that the students know how to use their devices in the classroom and have an introduction to the software that is regularly used.

The orientation session concludes at 12:00pm and we will share a lunch together until 12:30pm. After this, students who would like to play Trimester 1 sports will move to sport training. Their day concludes at the times listed below. Students not participating in Trimester 1 sports can be collected from Senior School Administration at 12:30pm.
